

# Official Call, 91st Rocky Mountain District Convention, Laramie, Wyoming August 12 – 15, 2010

Pursuant to Article VIII, Sec. 4 of the District Bylaws, as Secretary of the Rocky Mountain District of Kiwanis International, I do hereby issue an official call to the 91st District Convention to be held in Laramie, Wyoming, August 12-15, 2010. The said convention is called for the purpose of electing district officers, adopting resolutions, amending bylaws, and the transaction of other business that may be brought before the convention. *Publication in this electronic newspaper and to the district website satisfies the requirement in the Bylaws requiring an Official Call to the District Convention be issued to each of the district's chartered clubs.*

Article VIII, Sec. 6: “At any convention, each chartered club in **good standing** in the district shall be entitled to seat up to three (3) delegates. Two (2) of the delegates should be the President and President-designate. To assure proper representation, each club may choose up to three (3) alternate delegates. Any one club not otherwise represented may be represented by the Lieutenant Governor of the division in which the club is located.”

Article VIII, Sec. 8: “The delegates and their alternates shall be active, privileged, or senior members in good standing of the chartered clubs they represent and shall be elected by such clubs not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the annual convention or less than fifteen (15) days prior to the date of any special convention. Their election shall be evidenced by a certificate to the District Secretary duly authenticated by the President and Secretary of the club. Should any chartered club fail to so certify the election of its delegates and alternates, then the Committee on Credentials shall have the right to determine the seating of the delegates or alternates for such chartered club.” *The delegate forms will be mailed electronically to the clubs and posted on the district website [www.rmdkiwanis.com](http://www.rmdkiwanis.com) in early June.*

Article IV, Sec. 3: “Any member club that fails for two (2) consecutive years to have present at least one (1) delegate at the annual district convention, and within thirty (30) days after a request by the District Board of Trustees to furnish a satisfactory excuse for such failure, shall not be considered in good standing.”

Article IX, Sec. 2a: In accordance with provisions of this section, “Proposed resolutions may be submitted by a majority vote of a club's board of directors to the District Secretary not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the district convention. Proposed resolutions may also be submitted by the District Board of Trustees or originated by the Committee on Resolutions.

The Chairman of the Committee on Resolutions is Thomas C. Sullivan, 13643 W. Bates Ave., Lakewood CO 80228.

Article XIX, Sec. 1: “Amendments to these bylaws, if in conformity with the constitution and bylaws of Kiwanis International, may be adopted by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the delegates and delegates-at-large voting at any convention. Proposed amendments, which shall be submitted only by a club in good standing or by the District Board of Trustees, shall be received by the District Secretary at least sixty (60) days prior to the date of the convention. The Secretary shall send a copy of all proposed amendments to the secretary of each chartered club not less than thirty (30) days prior to the date of the convention.
