2009 BOULDER COUNTY TRENDS REPORT

Morgan Rogers, Civic Forum Director of The Community Foundation presented an enthusiastically inspired program on Boulder County TRENDS. Among the interesting factoids about Boulder County: Population is now 294,000 with 100,000 in Boulder (lost population in the recent past) and 87,000 in Longmont (growing rapidly). The median age in Boulder County is 36. 57% of Boulder County residents hold a bachelor's degree or higher (compared with 28% nationally). 91% of Young Children (ages 1 to 14) had health insurance coverage.
