APRIL 23, 2009 – LUNCH & PROGRAM

Front Range Rescue Dogs! Founded in 1984, Front Range Rescue Dogs, Inc. is an experienced, dynamic non-profit volunteer group committed to providing competent canine search & rescue teams during missing person emergencies. Working primarily in Boulder County, they have also assisted in searches throughout Colorado and neighboring states. The group is available to respond 24 hours a day, 365 days a year when called by law enforcement agencies (sheriff or police). John and Terry brought Rascal and Tia, two of the well-trained rescue dogs.

The dogs use “air scent” off leash and can track people through woods, mountains, open space, in parks, along rivers and ditches.

“Trailing” is on leash and best used when the track is humid. In July, the scent dries up quickly.

“Disaster” – dogs look for live victims in collapsed buildings. Two of their dogs from Longmont participated in the 9/11 World Trade Tower collapse in New York.

"Evidence" – the dogs find keys, radios, lost pagers, very practical at picnics!

"Avalanche" time is critical.

"Water" – the dogs locate drowning victims in murky lakes.

"Human remains" - suicides. There are a surprising number of suicides up on Flagstaff and in Left Hand Canyon.
