DEALING WITH HARD-TO-DEAL-WITH PEOPLE

The dynamic Elizabeth Gold led us in interactive sessions on how to successfully communicate through conflict. We learned that most people avoid conflict because we want everyone to like us. Silence = agreement, so speak up!

To solve a problem there are 4 things to think about:

What is the problem now?

What would a perfect day be like if this problem was solved?

Why isn't it like that now?

What do I need to do differently? (learning a new skill like driving, etc.)

Problems come in two flavors: System problems (phones, computers, etc.) and People problems.

Communication skills can be learned. The benefits of conflict are change and clarity. Don't be afraid of conflict. 75% of our success is due to our interactions with others. Remember Q-TIP "Quit Taking It Personally". Communication styles range from Aggressive to Passive. The golden middle group is ASSERTIVE. An assertive person: leads, expects everyone to be responsible, expresses expectations, sets boundaries, uses "I", is clear and specific, uses facts, expresses wants and needs and is not subjective.

The 3 step model to conflict resolution:

State the situation clearly; State what it affects (using much detail) and State what you need directly. Then be silent (the hardest part).
